

2	8B273	Lower radiator hose
3	W503276	Coolant pump assembly bolt (3 required)
4	8501	Coolant pump assembly
5	8507	Gasket

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Removal

- 1. Drain the cooling system. For additional information, refer to **COOLING SYSTEM DRAINING**, **FILLING AND BLEEDING**.
- 2. Remove the Air Cleaner (ACL) outlet pipe. For additional information, refer to <u>AIR CLEANER</u> <u>OUTLET PIPE</u>.
- 3. Disconnect the lower radiator hose from the thermostat housing.
- 4. Remove the coolant pump belt. For additional information, refer to **COOLANT PUMP BELT**.
- 5. Remove the 3 bolts and the coolant pump.
 - Remove and discard the gasket.

Installation

- 1. Using a new gasket, install the coolant pump and the 3 bolts.
 - Tighten to 10 Nm (89 lb-in).
- 2. Install the coolant pump belt. For additional information, refer to **COOLANT PUMP BELT**.
- 3. Connect the lower radiator hose to the thermostat housing.
- 4. Install the ACL outlet pipe. For additional information, refer to AIR CLEANER OUTLET PIPE.
- 5. Fill and bleed the cooling system. For additional information, refer to **COOLING SYSTEM DRAINING, FILLING AND BLEEDING**.
